



T-Mobile FAR/DFARS Flowdown Policy

Published: 5/6/2026

1. Policy Description

T-Mobile sells products and services to Government customers. The Government requires certain provisions are "flowed down" to our Suppliers (who are considered "Subcontractors" by the Government customer). Suppliers who maintain active registrations at SAM.gov for the same products and services they provide to T-Mobile may recognize many of these provisions ("Flowdowns") as part of the SAM.gov Contractor representations and certifications. All Subcontractors must have a Unique Entity ID (UEI) assigned by SAM.

2. Applicability

The requirements of this T-Mobile FAR/DFAR Flowdown Policy ("Flowdown Policy") only apply to Suppliers who provide goods or services that are ultimately used by T-Mobile in connection with a Government Contract. These Government Contracts may be with Federal, State, or Local Government agencies, or with other entities who receive federal funding.

Adherence to this Policy is necessary to ensure compliance with federal requirements and regulations. If the requirements of this Flowdown Policy conflict with the requirements in the Supplier's main contract with T-Mobile, the requirements described in this Flowdown Policy take precedence, unless the contract term is inclusive and more restrictive, or unless the contract term expressly supersedes specific Flowdown requirements.

3. Roles and Responsibilities

The Flowdowns listed in this Flowdown Policy are listed in shorthand and shall have the same force and effect as if they were given in full text.

Supplier must:

1. Adhere to the applicable Flowdowns within this Flowdown Policy;
2. Complete risk questionnaires, as required;
3. Provide Voluntary Product Accessibility Templates (VPATs) or other product-specific documentation that may be requested or required related to specific OEM products sold; and
4. Complete compliance attestations as requested by T-Mobile.

4. Flowdown Requirements

The applicable clauses identified herein are incorporated by reference with the same force and effect as if set forth in full text and made a part of the Supplier's contract. The full text of the clauses identified herein are spelled out in the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS). Supplier has to comply with the clauses, including flow down obligations, that, by their terms, are mandatory based on the nature of the products and services that Supplier provides in support of a Government Contract.

E. Required to Sell to Department of Homeland Security: All of A-C above, plus:

All clauses listed shall, with respect to the rights, duties and obligations of T-Mobile and Supplier hereunder, will be interpreted and construed in such manner as to recognize and give effect to: (i) the contractual relationship between T-Mobile and Supplier under the contract, (ii) the rights of any higher-tier contractor supporting the Government Contract, and (iii) the rights of the United States Government.

Clauses that are not applicable based on dollar threshold are self-deleting. They will not be removed from this document but are deemed without force and effect. It is Supplier’s obligation to contact T-Mobile regarding any confusion, ambiguity, or questions Supplier may have regarding applicability of any of the above clauses.

6. Continuous Assessment; notice of Non-Compliance

Supplier must continuously reassess its compliance with this Flowdown Policy and promptly notify T-Mobile at VendorNotifications@T-Mobile.com following Supplier's determination that it cannot or will no longer be able to meet the obligations of this Flowdown Policy.
