Our mission is to provide access and fair & equitable opportunities for all our suppliers while growing a robust supply chain that reflects our Un-carrier diversity and values. When this happens, our customer relationships are strengthened and the communities we serve can continue to develop and thrive. Not only are you an integral part of this development, but as a registered diverse supplier with T-Mobile and the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), if your company earns less than \$10M in total annual revenue, you benefit from contract visibility and net 30 payment terms – so you can maximize your opportunities and do more with your time and resources.

WHAT ARE THE STEPS TO JOIN THE PROGRAM?

1. Get nationally certified with at least one of the following organizations:
National Minority Supplier Development Council (NMSDC), Women's Business Enterprise National Council (WBENC), National Gay and Lesbian Chamber of Commerce (NGLCC), National Veteran Business Development Council (NVBDC), Disability:IN
2. Self-Certify your small business with the Small Business Administration (SBA) if you meet the criteria. SBA size standards define whether a business entity is small and, thus, eligible for government programs and preferences reserved for "small business" concerns. Size standards have been established for types of economic activity, or industry, generally under the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). Small businesses meeting SBA size standards can self-certify their companies at sam.gov. HUBZones and 8a businesses must certify at [SBA.gov](https://sba.gov).
3. Get Certified with CPUC: Initiate a request for certification as a diverse supplier by the CPUC Supplier Clearinghouse: thesupplierclearinghouse.com.
4. Sign Up: Register on our site, <https://t-mobile.supplierone.co>. Fill out your company profile completely and keep your certifications and profile up-to-date going forward.
