What is the ELD mandate?

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Transportation (DoT), created a regulation to help improve road safety and reduce the number of accidents that happen throughout the United States.

Their solution: the [electronic logging device mandate](#), or ELD mandate.

Using ELDs instead of paper logs and AOBDRs is already compulsory, but on December 16th, 2019, it became law that your ELDs are both up-to-date, and in line with all mandate requirements.

Why the ELD mandate matters
