

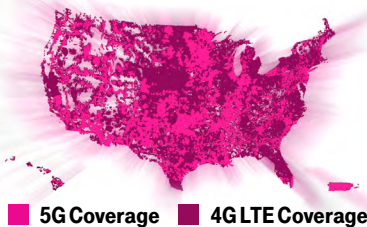


Verizon covers parts of 18 cities and a few sport venues (30 cities by end of year)

Map includes 600 MHz coverage; capable device required.



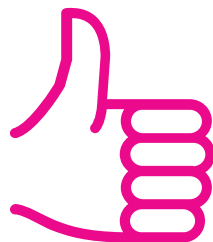
Confined to parts of some cities

Works indoors and out



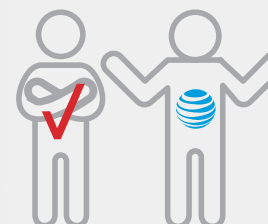
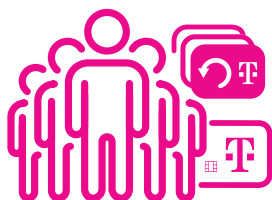
Verizon 5G blocked by things like walls, windows and leaves
