WE SAID:

T-Mobile's 5G Home Internet offering is bringing disruptive competition to consumers across the country, including in rural areas where consumers previously had no competitive alternatives. T-Mobile foresaw that the merger would fundamentally shift the competitive landscape for in-home broadband.⁴¹ The tremendous gains in network speed, capacity, and signal strength made possible by T-Mobile's 5G network would allow the company to bring robust and disruptive competition to this segment.⁴² By helping to eliminate the speed and capacity differential between mobile wireless and in-home wired broadband service, millions of American consumers would get the opportunity to "cut the cord" and use their mobile T-Mobile wireless service as their broadband service both inside and outside the home, while pocketing the savings from T-Mobile's elimination of an unnecessary and costly wired broadband bill.⁴³

T-Mobile committed to offering in-home broadband service with minimum speeds of 25/3 Mbps and average download speeds greater than 100 Mbps, at a price significantly below incumbent providers' comparable offerings, and with no equipment or installation charges, and no contracts.⁴⁴ T-Mobile committed to offering its in-home broadband service to at least 28 million eligible households nationwide, including at least 5.6 million households in rural areas.⁴⁵

WE DELIVERED:

5G is already proving to be a game changer, both in the mobile and fixed broadband sectors. T-Mobile Home Internet is now available to tens of millions of homes nationwide, including in rural areas where consumers previously had little or no choice among broadband providers—all for just \$50.

T-Mobile is the fastest growing in-home broadband provider in America, reaching more than 1 million subscribers just one year after launching the service and more than 2.6 million customers by the end of 2022.⁴⁶ More and more customers are choosing T-Mobile over traditional fixed broadband because we offer simple set-up, no annual contract, no monthly taxes or fees, and excellent customer support.⁴⁷ T-Mobile only intends to continue growing from here. We fully expect that by 2025, we will have more than 7 million home internet subscribers.⁴⁸ T-Mobile has expanded our in-home broadband availability to 50 million eligible households, all covered by 5G.⁴⁹
